AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 13, 1836 (P.L.551, No.169), entitled  
2 "An act relating to roads, highways and bridges," repealing  
3 provisions relating to power of courts to change or vacate  
4 roads.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 20 of the act of June 13, 1836 (P.L.551,  
8 No.169), referred to as the General Road Law, is repealed.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
