AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing payments to certain entities for the purchase of
- 2 automatic external defibrillators; providing for powers and
- duties of the Department of Education; requiring certain
- 4 training; providing for civil immunity for certain users of
- 5 automated external defibrillators; and making an
- 6 appropriation.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Short title.
- 10 This act shall be known and may be cited as the School
- 11 Automatic External Defibrillator Access Act.
- 12 Section 2. Declaration of policy.
- 13 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 14 (1) A number of school-age students and adults in this
- 15 Commonwealth have been tragically stricken with sudden
- 16 cardiac arrest while in school or participating in school-

- 1 sponsored activities.
- 2 (2) In recent years, the use of automated external
- defibrillators has been proven to strengthen the chain of
- 4 survival for cardiac arrest victims.
- 5 (3) It is important for the Commonwealth to ensure that
- 6 school buildings are equipped with automatic external
- 7 defibrillators and staffed with personnel trained to use the
- 8 devices.
- 9 Section 3. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Automated external defibrillator." A portable device that
- 14 uses electric shock to restore a stable heart rhythm to an
- 15 individual in cardiac arrest.
- 16 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 17 Commonwealth.
- 18 "School entity." An area vocational-technical school, a
- 19 charter school, an intermediate unit or a school district.
- 20 "Secretary." The Secretary of Education of the Commonwealth.
- 21 Section 4. Automatic external defibrillator wholesale purchase
- 22 program.
- 23 (a) Establishment.--The department shall establish an
- 24 automatic external defibrillator wholesale purchase program to
- 25 help ensure that school entities have automatic external
- 26 defibrillators available for use in school buildings where
- 27 classes or school-sponsored activities routinely occur. Under
- 28 the program, the department shall pay to a school entity an
- 29 amount not less than 50% of the school entity's cost to purchase
- 30 UP TO one automatic external defibrillator per building.

- 1 (b) Statewide contract.--The department shall issue an
- 2 invitation to bid for the cost of automatic external
- 3 defibrillators and shall enter into a contract with the
- 4 successful bidder that permits any school entity to receive the
- 5 contract price for the devices from the successful bidder.
- 6 (c) Eligibility for program. -- To be eligible for payment
- 7 under the AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR WHOLESALE PURCHASE
- 8 program a school entity must:
- 9 (1) Employ three or more persons who are assigned to the
- 10 respective building where the automatic external
- defibrillator will be primarily housed and who are trained to
- 12 use the device.
- 13 (2) Ensure that the device will be secured in a safe and
- readily accessible location within the school building with
- the appropriate supplies and agree to properly maintain and
- inspect the device as recommended by the department in
- 17 consultation with the American Heart Association and the
- 18 Department of Health.
- 19 (3) Submit a valid prescription for the device from a
- 20 licensed medical practitioner in this Commonwealth.
- 21 (4) Purchase the device through the Statewide contract
- 22 authorized under subsection (b).
- 23 (5) Agree to provide the training required by section 5.
- 24 (D) VOLUNTARY NATURE OF PROGRAM. -- NO SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL BE

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- 25 REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR
- 26 WHOLESALE PURCHASE PROGRAM.
- 27 Section 5. Training.
- 28 (a) General rule.--School entity ALL SCHOOL personnel who
- 29 are expected to use automated external defibrillators shall
- 30 complete training in the use of an automated external

- 1 defibrillator provided by the American Heart Association or
- 2 through an equivalent course of instruction approved by the
- 3 Department of Health in consultation with a technical committee
- 4 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Health Services Council.
- 5 (b) Part of continuing education plan. -- A school entity may
- 6 include the training in its continuing education plan submitted
- 7 to the department under section 1205.1 of the act of March 10,
- 8 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949.
- 9 Section 6. Nonpublic schools.
- 10 (A) ESTABLISHMENT. -- To the extent that funds are available
- 11 beginning February 1, 2002, from the appropriation made under
- 12 section 9 10, the department shall establish a program to
- 13 furnish automatic external defibrillators to nonpublic schools
- 14 through the Commonwealth's intermediate units. To be eligible to <

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- 15 receive an COMMONWEALTH'S INTERMEDIATE UNITS.
- 16 (B) ELIGIBILITY FOR PROGRAM. -- TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN
- 17 automatic external defibrillator from an intermediate unit, a
- 18 nonpublic school must:
- 19 (1) Employ three or more persons who are assigned to the
- 20 respective building where the automatic external
- 21 defibrillator will be primarily housed and who are trained to
- 22 use the device.
- 23 (2) Ensure that the device will be secured in a safe and
- 24 readily accessible location within the school building with
- 25 the appropriate supplies and agree to properly maintain and
- inspect the device as recommended by the department in
- 27 consultation with the American Heart Association and the
- Department of Health of this Commonwealth.
- 29 (3) Submit a valid prescription for the device from a
- 30 licensed medical practitioner in this Commonwealth.

- 1 (4) Agree to provide the training required by section 5.
- 2 (C) VOLUNTARY NATURE OF PROGRAM. -- NO NONPUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL <--
- 3 BE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL
- 4 DEFIBRILLATOR WHOLESALE PURCHASE PROGRAM.
- 5 Section 7. Civil immunity for users of automated external
- 6 defibrillators.
- 7 The provisions of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8331.2 (relating to Good
- 8 Samaritan civil immunity for use of automatic external
- 9 defibrillator) shall apply to all school employees who have
- 10 received training as required under section 5 and who render
- 11 care with an automated external defibrillator while in the scope
- 12 of their employment.
- 13 Section 8. Report.
- No later than June 30, 2002, the secretary shall submit a
- 15 report to the General Assembly describing the effectiveness of
- 16 the act in outfitting the Commonwealth's schools with automatic
- 17 external defibrillators.
- 18 Section 9. Regulations.
- 19 The department may promulgate regulations as necessary to
- 20 administer this act.
- 21 Section 10. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$6,300,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 23 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Education
- 24 for the fiscal year July 1, 2001, to June 30, 2002, for the
- 25 administration of this act.
- 26 Section 11. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect on July 1, 2001, or immediately,
- 28 whichever is later.
