## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for contempt for
- 3 noncompliance with support order.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4345 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4345. Contempt for noncompliance with support order.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- A person who willfully fails to comply
- 10 with any order under this chapter, except an order subject to
- 11 section 4344 (relating to contempt for failure of obligor to
- 12 appear), may, as prescribed by general rule, be adjudged in
- 13 contempt, a misdemeanor of the third degree. Contempt shall be
- 14 punishable by any one or more of the following:
- 15 (1) Imprisonment for a period not to exceed six months.
- 16 (2) A fine not to exceed \$1,000.

- 1 (3) Probation for a period not to exceed one year.
- 2 (b) Condition for release. -- An order committing a defendant
- 3 to jail under this section shall specify the condition the
- 4 fulfillment of which will result in the release of the obligor.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
