AN ACT

1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the Pennsylvania Public  
3 Utility Commission from requiring the structured separation  
4 of services of telecommunications service providers.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 531. Prohibition against structural separation.

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the commission is  
11 hereby prohibited from requiring the structural separation of  
12 component entities, functions or services of any  
13 telecommunications service provider regulated by or otherwise  
14 under the jurisdiction of the commission.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
