AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, prohibiting children under the age of ten from
- 3 riding in front seat of passenger vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 4581.1. Child passenger in front seat.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), no
- 10 person shall operate a passenger car unless all passengers under
- 11 the age of ten are seated in a seat behind the front seat if the
- 12 passenger car is equipped with a middle or rear seat.
- 13 (b) Exception. -- A person may operate a passenger vehicle
- 14 with a child under the age of ten in the front seat if all
- 15 middle and rear seat positions are occupied by children under
- 16 the age of ten and the oldest child in the vehicle, other than
- 17 the operator, is the child occupying the front seat.
- 18 (c) Penalty. -- Any person who operates a passenger car in

- 1 violation of this section commits a summary offense and shall,
- 2 upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than
- 3 \$25.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
