Section 1. Section 614(a) and (c) of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, amended August 14, 1997 (P.L.530, No.57), are amended to read: <-----

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SECTION 1. SECTION 207.1 OF THE ACT OF APRIL 9, 1929
(P.L.177, NO.175), KNOWN AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1929, IS
AMENDED BY ADDING A SUBSECTION TO READ:

9 SECTION 207.1. GUBERNATORIAL APPOINTMENTS.--* * *

10 (H) THE GOVERNOR MAY NOT NOMINATE AN INDIVIDUAL AS A MEMBER
11 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION IF, BECAUSE OF
12 THAT INDIVIDUAL'S PARTY AFFILIATION UNDER 25 PA.C.S. PT. IV
13 (RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION) AT THE TIME OF NOMINATION,
14 APPOINTMENT OF THE INDIVIDUAL WOULD RESULT IN MORE THAN THREE
15 MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION HAVING THE SAME PARTY AFFILIATION AS
16 THE GOVERNOR.

17 SECTION 2. SECTION 614(A) AND (C) OF THE ACT, AMENDED AUGUST 18 14, 1997 (P.L.530, NO.57), ARE AMENDED TO READ:

19 Section 614. List of Employes to be Furnished to Certain 20 State Officers.--(a) All administrative departments, boards, 21 and commissions and the Attorney General shall on July 15 of 22 each year, transmit to the Auditor General, the State Treasurer 23 and Secretary of the Budget a complete list, and to the 24 Legislative Data Processing Center a computer tape of such list, 25 as of July 1 preceding, of the names of all persons, except day-26 laborers, entitled to receive compensation from the Commonwealth 27 for services rendered in or to the department, board, or 28 commission, as the case may be. Such list shall show FOR EACH 29 <u>SUCH PERSON</u> the position occupied [by each such person], the 30 date of birth [and], COUNTY OF RESIDENCE, voting residence [of - 2 -20010H1331B4680

such person], the salary at which or other basis upon which such 1 <person is entitled to be paid, the date [when such person 2 <-----3 entered] OF ENTRY INTO the service of the Commonwealth, whether <-----4 such person has been continuously employed by the Commonwealth 5 since that date, and all periods of service and positions held as an employe of the Commonwealth, or such part of such 6 information <u>RELATED TO PREVIOUS SERVICE AND POSITIONS</u> as the 7 <----Governor may prescribe. Notwithstanding the preceding 8 <----9 requirement, the lists of persons furnished by the Department of 10 Corrections, the Board of Probation and Parole and the Pardons 11 Board shall also list the county of residence of each person. * * * 12 (c) The information received by the Auditor General, the 13 14 State Treasurer and the Secretary of the Budget, under this 15 section, shall be public information[.], except that the 16 information identifying the voting residence of the persons 17 furnished by the Department of Corrections, the Board of <-----18 Probation and Parole and the Pardons Board is not EMPLOYED BY <-----19 THE COMMONWEALTH SHALL NOT BE public information and may not be 20 treated as such. 21 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: <----22 Section 2802. Membership. Not more than three members of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission shall be of the same 23 24 political party. 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
