8	Section 1. The act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), known
9	as The Third Class City Code, reenacted and amended June 28,
10	1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended by adding a section to read:
11	Section 803. Residency Requirement No person shall be
12	appointed to fill a vacancy in an elected city office unless he
13	or she has resided within the city continuously for at least one
14	year immediately prior to his or her appointment.
15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
