AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled,  
2 as amended, "An act counties of the first, third, fourth,  
3 fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,  
4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto;  
5 relating to imposition of excise taxes by counties, including  
6 authorizing imposition of an excise tax on the rental of  
7 motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and providing  
8 for regional renaissance initiatives," further providing for  
9 the assistant county solicitors.

10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
11 hereby enacts as follows:

12 Section 1. Section 904 of the act of August 9, 1955  
13 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, amended December  
14 22, 1981 (P.L.524, No.147), is amended to read:

15 Section 904. Assistant County Solicitors.--The county  
16 commissioners may appoint [not more than three] one or more  
17 assistant county solicitors, and, with the approval of the court  
18 of common pleas, special counsel who shall be attorneys at law  
19 admitted to practice in the courts of this Commonwealth. Each

1 assistant and special counsel shall perform such duties in  
2 connection with the legal affairs of the county as may be  
3 assigned to him by the county commissioners or the county  
4 solicitor.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
