Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for cruelty to 3 animals. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 5511(a)(2.1)(ii) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 5511. Cruelty to animals. (a) Killing, maiming or poisoning domestic animals or zoo 9 10 animals, etc.--11 12 (2.1)13 (ii) Any person convicted of violating the 14 provisions of this paragraph shall be sentenced to pay a 15 fine of not less than \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not more than [two] five years, or both. The court may also 16

- order a presentence mental evaluation. A subsequent
 conviction under this paragraph shall be a felony of the
 third degree. This paragraph shall apply to dogs and cats
 only.
