AN ACT

- Designating a section of State Route 1011 in Clearfield, Cameron and Elk Counties as the Quehanna Highway.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Quehanna Highway.
- 6 (a) Designation.--The section of State Route 1011 that runs
- 7 from Route 879 near Karthous KARTHAUS, in Clearfield County
- 8 through the Quehanna Wild Area in Cameron and Elk Counties and
- 9 ends at State Route 555 at Medix Run in Elk County, is
- 10 designated and shall be known as the Quehanna Highway.
- 11 (b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 12 maintain appropriate signs at each end of the section of highway
- 13 identifying the portion of road described in subsection (a) as
- 14 the Quehanna Highway.
- 15 Section 2. Effective date.
