## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for areas to commemorate POWs and MIAs at rest stops
- 2 and welcome centers and for coordination and cost sharing
- 3 with veterans' organizations.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. POW/MIA areas.
- 7 The Department of Transportation shall set aside an area of
- 8 at least one-quarter acre in size to commemorate POWs and MIAs
- 9 at each of the rest stops on State highways and State-owned
- 10 welcome centers. These areas shall continuously display the
- 11 official POW/MIA flag from a lighted flagpole until all POWs and
- 12 MIAs return or are accounted for.
- 13 Section 2. Markers.
- 14 The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain

- 1 appropriate markers to designate the POW/MIA areas. The markers
- 2 may consist of signs, plaques, statues or other commemorative
- 3 objects.
- 4 Section 3. Coordination with veterans' organizations.
- 5 The Department of Transportation shall coordinate with
- 6 veterans' organizations throughout this Commonwealth to further
- 7 develop memorials or other methods of recognition of POWs and
- 8 MIAs for the designated areas.
- 9 Section 4. Cost sharing.
- 10 The Department of Transportation may not erect and maintain
- 11 any commemorative objects, other than signs, under this act
- 12 unless the cost of such objects are shared between veterans'
- 13 organizations and the Commonwealth. The department may negotiate
- 14 and enter into agreements with veterans' organizations to
- 15 satisfy the requirements of this section.
- 16 Section 5. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
