## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 9, 1990 (P.L.340, No.78), entitled "An act providing for a Statewide emergency telephone number 911 3 system; providing for contributions from telephone 4 subscribers; providing a penalty; and making a repeal," 5 providing for telephone customer service addresses to be 6 printed on service bills. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- (d) Notification. -- All local telephone exchange service 14
- 15 companies shall provide notification of each customer's service
- 16 address in the customer's monthly billing for service.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 17
