## AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for driving under the influence 3 of alcohol or controlled substance and for surcharges. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Sections 3731(e)(1)(iv), 3742(b) and 6 6506(a)(7)(iii) and (iv) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 3731. Driving under influence of alcohol or controlled 10 substance. 11 12 (e) Penalty.--13 (1) Any person violating any of the provisions of this 14 section is quilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree,
- (1) Any person violating any of the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, except that a person convicted of a third or subsequent offense is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree, and the sentencing court shall order the person to pay a fine of

- 14 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any
- person violating this section commits a misdemeanor of the

- 18 person violating subsection (a) commits a felony of the
- 19 [third] second degree, and the sentencing court shall order
- 20 the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not
- less than [90 days] one year and a mandatory minimum fine of
- [\$1,000] \$2,500, notwithstanding any other provision of law.
