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## AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, providing for a Pride in America registration  
3 plate.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1361. Pride in America plate.

9 Upon application of any person who has EITHER contributed at <—  
10 least \$50 to a charitable organization or relief fund which  
11 benefits victims of terrorism or war OR SERVED AS A RESCUE OR <—  
12 RECOVERY WORKER FOR VICTIMS OF TERRORISM OR WAR ANYTIME  
13 BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 11, 2001, OR THEREAFTER, accompanied by A <—  
14 FEE OF \$20 WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO the annual registration  
15 fee and such documentation as the department shall require, the

1 ~~department shall issue to such person a special registration~~ <—  
2 ~~plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a~~  
3 ~~person who has so contributed~~ PRIDE IN AMERICA REGISTRATION <—  
4 PLATE. The Department of State shall identify and prepare, <—  
5 PREPARE AND MAINTAIN a list of approved charitable organizations  
6 and relief funds for purposes of this section. THIS LIST SHALL <—  
7 INCLUDE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS REGISTERED UNDER THE ACT OF  
8 DECEMBER 19, 1990 (P.L.1200, NO.202), KNOWN AS THE SOLICITATION  
9 OF FUNDS FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES ACT, AND ANY CORPORATION  
10 ESTABLISHED BY AN ACT OF CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES THAT IS  
11 REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW TO SUBMIT ANNUAL REPORTS OF ITS  
12 ACTIVITIES TO CONGRESS CONTAINING ITEMIZED ACCOUNTS OF ALL  
13 RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES AFTER BEING FULLY AUDITED BY THE  
14 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE. The special registration plate may be  
15 used only on a passenger car, MOTOR HOME, TRAILER or truck with <—  
16 a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.  
17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
