7	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated	
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:	
9	<u>§ 1361. Pride in America plate.</u>	
10	<u>Upon application of any person who has either contributed at</u>	<
11	<del>least \$50</del> to a charitable organization or relief fund which	
12	benefits victims of terrorism or war or served as a rescue or	
13	recovery worker for victims of terrorism or war anytime	
14	beginning September 11, 2001, or thereafter, accompanied by a	
15	fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration	
16	fee and such documentation as the department shall require, the	<

1	<u>department shall issue to such person a <del>special</del> Pride in America</u>	<-
2	registration plate. The Department of State shall identify,	<-
3	prepare and maintain a list of approved charitable organizations	
4	and relief funds for purposes of this section. This list shall	
5	include charitable organizations registered under the act of	
6	December 19, 1990 (P.L.1200, No.202), known as the Solicitation	
7	of Funds for Charitable Purposes Act, and any corporation	
8	established by an act of Congress of the United States that is	
9	required by Federal law to submit annual reports of its	
10	activities to Congress containing itemized accounts of all	
11	receipts and expenditures after being fully audited by the	
12	Department of Defense. The special registration plate may be	
13	used only on a passenger car, motor home, trailer or truck with	
14	a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.	
15	SECTION 2. (A) THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE	<-
16	SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE FOLLOWING:	
17	(1) THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSOLIDATING THE PENNSYLVANIA	
18	TURNPIKE COMMISSION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.	
19	(2) COMPETITIVE BIDDING OF BONDS ISSUED BY THE	
20	PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE COMMISSION.	
21	(3) ELIMINATING PATRONAGE PRACTICES IN FILLING POSITIONS	
22	WITHIN THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE COMMISSION AND INCLUDING	
23	THESE POSITIONS WITHIN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE UNDER THE ACT	
24	OF AUGUST 5, 1941 (P.L.752, NO.286), KNOWN AS THE CIVIL	
25	SERVICE ACT.	
26	(4) CONTRACTING PROCEDURES AND PRACTICES.	
27	(B) THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY, INCLUDING THE RECOMMENDATIONS	
28	OF THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, SHALL BE	

29 COMPLETED AND MADE AVAILABLE TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SIX MONTHS 30 AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.
