## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for special library registration plates.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1361. Library plates.

The department, in consultation with the Department of Education and representatives from the district library centers' advisory councils, shall design a special library registration plate. Upon application of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall issue the plate for a passenger car or other vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds. The library which solicited the purchase of the

1 library registration plate shall receive $\$ 15$ of each additional
2 fee for this plate.
3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
