- 10 (b) Offense defined.--A person commits a [misdemeanor]
- 11 felony of the [first] third degree if he possesses a weapon in
- 12 the buildings of, on the grounds of, or in any conveyance
- 13 providing transportation to or from any elementary or secondary
- 14 publicly-funded educational institution, any elementary or
- 15 secondary private school licensed by the Department of Education

- 1 or any elementary or secondary parochial school.
