AN ACT

1 Providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 2002-2003.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Short title and construction.

5 (a) Short title.--This act shall be known and may be cited6 as the Capital Budget Act of 2002-2003.

7 (b) Supplements.--A reference to this act shall be deemed to8 include a reference to the supplements to this act.

9 (c) Capital Facilities Debt Enabling Act.--The provisions 10 and definitions of Chapter 3 of the act of February 9, 1999 11 (P.L.1, No.1), known as The Capital Facilities Debt Enabling 12 Act, shall apply to this act to the extent they are not 13 inconsistent with this act.

14 Section 2. Overall limitations on debt to be incurred for15 capital projects.

16 The maximum principal amount of additional debt to be 17 incurred during the 2002-2003 fiscal year, for capital projects

specifically itemized in a capital budget pursuant to section 1 2 7(a)(4) of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, and 3 the fund to be charged with the repayment of such debt, shall, 4 with respect to each category of capital projects, be as 5 follows: 6 Category Amount Fund 7 (1) Public Improvement 8 Projects: 9 (i) Buildings and General Fund or \$250,000,000 Special Fund as 10 Structures applicable 11 12 (ii) Furniture and 40,000,000 13 Equipment (2) Transportation 14 15 Assistance Projects 150,000,000 General Fund 16 (3) Redevelopment Assistance Projects 260,000,000 17 General Fund 18 (4) Flood Control 6,000,000 19 General Fund Projects \$706,000,000 20 Total 21 Section 3. Effective date. 22 This act shall take effect July 1, 2002, or immediately, 23 whichever is later.
