## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, "further providing for the State share
- of total actual instructional cost.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2501 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 11 amended by adding a clause to read:
- 12 Section 2501. Definitions.--For the purposes of this article
- 13 the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 (12) "State Share of Total Actual Instructional Cost." The
- 16 total amount of basic education funding in a school year as

- 1 provided for in section 2502 divided by the figure calculated as
- 2 the sum of the actual instructional expense as defined in clause
- 3 (11.1) for all districts less the amount received from the State
- 4 for payments for Social Security and pension contributions.

- 6 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 <u>Section 2502.40. State Share of Total Actual Instructional</u>
- 8 Cost.--For the school year 2001-2002 and each year thereafter,
- 9 the State's share of total actual instructional cost shall be no
- 10 <u>less than fifty per centum (50%).</u>
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
