## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating May 1 through 6, 2001, as "Medicare Awareness Week"  
2 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, There are more than 2 million people with Medicare  
4 in this Commonwealth; and

5 WHEREAS, People with Medicare have certain rights under  
6 Medicare, but many enrollees are not aware of these rights; and

7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is in a new century when people with  
8 Medicare are expected to be informed health care consumers; and

9 WHEREAS, The importance of education in addressing specific  
10 health care issues is particularly essential to people with  
11 Medicare; and

1       WHEREAS, Keystone Peer Review Organization (KePRO) works to  
2 protect patient rights and improve the health care provided to  
3 all people on Medicare in Pennsylvania; therefore be it

4       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 1  
5 through 6, 2001, as "Medicare Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
