- 8 WHEREAS, The American Flag is known across the world as an
- 9 emblem of liberty and justice for all people; and
- 10 WHEREAS, It is important that all Americans, especially our

- 2 preservation of our union as well as our commitment to freedom
- 3 and equality embodied in the American Flag; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 5 school districts to show proper respect for our country and its
