A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of March 2002 as "Multiple Sclerosis
- 2 Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Multiple sclerosis is a chronic and often disabling
- 4 disease of the central nervous system which often first appears
- 5 in people between the ages of 20 and 40, with lifelong physical
- 6 and emotional effects; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Multiple sclerosis is twice as common in women as in
- 8 men; and
- 9 WHEREAS, An estimated 250,000 to 350,000 individuals suffer

- 1 from multiple sclerosis nationally; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Symptoms of multiple sclerosis can be mild, such as
- 3 numbness in the limbs, or severe, such as paralysis or loss of
- 4 vision; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The progress, severity and specific symptoms of
- 6 multiple sclerosis in any one person cannot yet be predicted;
- 7 therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 9 month of March 2002 as "Multiple Sclerosis Awareness Month" in
- 10 Pennsylvania.
