## A RESOLUTION

Declaring the support of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives for Israel's defense against terrorism and pursuit of peace.

WHEREAS, The State of Israel, founded in 1948, has long sought to achieve peace with its neighbors, concluding peace treaties with Egypt and Jordan and seeking a peaceful solution to the conflict with the Palestinians leading to the Oslo

Agreement in 1993 and the Camp David Summit in the summer of 2000; and

WHEREAS, Since September 2000 the people of Israel have experienced constant violence from areas under the control of the Palestinian Authority; and

WHEREAS, The people of Israel have experienced repeated terrorist attacks directed against the civilian population by Palestinian terrorist groups; and

WHEREAS, The State of Israel is the only democratic state in the Middle East and a strong and consistent ally of the United States; and

WHEREAS, The many friends and supporters of the state of Israel from all parts of this Commonwealth have joined with like-minded people throughout the United States in April 2002 to publicly express their support and solidarity with that country; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Pennsylvania House of Representatives declare that we stand with the people and the government of the State of Israel as Israel defends against terrorism and pursues peace.
