AN ACT

- 1 Providing for leaving the Pennsylvania Turnpike at other than
- 2 established interchanges under emergency conditions.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Leaving turnpike for emergency repairs.
- 6 A person operating a passenger motor vehicle, as defined by
- 7 the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission regulations, experiencing
- 8 emergency difficulties due to the malfunction of the vehicle
- 9 while traversing the turnpike is hereby authorized, under
- 10 supervision of the Pennsylvania State Police, to leave the
- 11 turnpike at an available exit located adjacent to a turnpike
- 12 garage area to secure local service for the emergency repairs
- 13 without the necessity of being towed.
- 14 Section 2. Payment of toll.
- 15 A person availing himself of section 1 shall, prior to
- 16 leaving the Pennsylvania Turnpike, pay to the Pennsylvania State
- 17 Police supervising the exit of the vehicle an amount equal to

- 1 the total charge for traversing the full length of the turnpike.
- 2 Section 3. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
