AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for the offense of dumping of vehicles in
- 3 cities of the first class.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3712.1. Dumping of vehicles in cities of the first class.
- 9 (a) Offense defined.--It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 10 place any abandoned or nonrepairable vehicle on any highway or
- 11 public or private property with the intent of permanently
- 12 <u>dumping such vehicle</u>.
- 13 (b) Presumption of dumping.--If an abandoned or
- 14 nonrepairable vehicle is placed at any location at least five
- 15 blocks from the address of the last known owner of such vehicle,
- 16 <u>a rebuttable presumption that the vehicle has been dumped shall</u>
- 17 arise which may be rebutted only by clear and convincing
- 18 evidence.

- 1 (c) Penalties.--
- 2 (1) For a first offense, a person violating subsection
- 3 (a) commits a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall, upon
- 4 conviction, pay a fine of \$1,000 plus all costs of disposing
- 5 of such vehicle under the provisions of Chapter 73 (relating
- 6 <u>to abandoned vehicles and cargos).</u>
- 7 (2) For a second or subsequent offense, a person
- 8 <u>violating subsection (a) commits a misdemeanor of the second</u>
- 9 <u>degree and shall, upon conviction, pay a fine of \$2,000 plus</u>
- 10 <u>all costs of disposing of such vehicle under the provisions</u>
- of Chapter 73.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
