7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Section 405 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
9	No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and
10	amended November 9, 1995 (P.L.350, No.60), is amended to read:
11	Section 405. Assessor(a) At the municipal election in
12	the year 1993 and at the municipal election every four years
13	after that, the electors of each township shall elect one
14	assessor to serve for a term of four years, except when
15	vacancies create shorter terms, from the first Monday of January
16	after the election. Assessors shall reside in the township from
17	which elected and shall have resided in that township
18	continuously for at least one year immediately preceding their
19	election.

1 (b) This section does not authorize the election of 2 assessors for taxation purposes:

3 (1) in counties where boards for the assessment and revision of taxes are authorized by law to appoint assessors[.]; or 4

5 (2) in any township where a county assesses property on

6 behalf of the township.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
