AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for reporting of firearm
- 3 theft or loss.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6115.1. Owner to report theft or loss of firearm.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Any person, licensed dealer, licensed
- 10 importer or licensed manufacturer who discovers that a firearm,
- 11 to which he holds a possessory interest as evidenced by the
- 12 provisions of this chapter, has been stolen or lost shall report
- 13 such to the local police or to the Pennsylvania State Police if
- 14 he resides in an area without local police. The report must be
- 15 made within 48 hours of the discovery of the theft or loss of
- 16 the firearm.
- 17 (b) Penalty.--Failure to make a report required under
- 18 subsection (a) constitutes a misdemeanor of the third degree.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
