8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 9502.1. Suspension of tax.
10	(a) General rule The Governor, by proclamation or
11	executive order, may suspend implementation, in part or in
12	total, of section 9502 (relating to imposition of tax) if:
13	(1) the average wholesale price for all liquid fuels and
14	fuels, as defined in Chapter 90 (relating to liquid fuels and
15	fuels tax), has experienced a more than 10% increase within a
16	period of one month or less; and
17	(2) the Governor, in his discretion, determines that the
18	increase in average wholesale price is detrimental to the

health, safety and welfare of the citizens of this

- 2 (b) Proclamation or executive order. -- A proclamation or
- 3 <u>executive order under subsection (a) shall remain in effect for</u>
- 4 up to three months and may be reissued by the Governor.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
