AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for notification requirements for
3 drivers and for penalties.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1604(a) and (d) of Title 75 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section
8 is amended by adding a subsection to read:

9 § 1604. Notification requirements for drivers.

10 (a) Notification of convictions.--A driver of a commercial
11 motor vehicle holding a driver's license issued by this
12 Commonwealth who is convicted of violating a Federal or state
13 law or local ordinance relating to motor vehicle traffic control
14 in this or any other state or any Federal, provincial,
15 territorial or municipal law relating to motor vehicle traffic
16 control in Canada, other than parking violations, shall notify
17 his employer in writing of the conviction within [30] 15 days of
18 the date of conviction.

2 (c.1) Notification of driving record.--Any person who
3 applies for employment as a commercial motor vehicle driver
4 shall provide the employer, at the time of the application for
5 employment, with a certified copy of the applicant's driving
6 record for each state in which the applicant has held a
7 commercial driver's license.

8 (d) Penalties.--

9 (1) Any person who violates subsection (a) [or (c)], (c)
10 or (c.1) commits a summary offense and shall, upon
11 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of [\$100] \$300.

12 (2) Any person who violates subsection (b) commits a
13 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
14 pay a fine of [\$200] \$500.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
