AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of General Services, with the 2 approval of the Governor, to grant and convey certain tracts 3 of land situate in Haverford Township, Delaware County. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Haverford Township, Delaware County. 7 The Department of General Services, with the approval of 8 the Governor, is hereby authorized on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to grant and convey to Haverford Township, or 9 its assigns, certain land and buildings known as Haverford State 10 11 Hospital described in subsection (b) under terms and conditions 12 to be established in an THE Agreement of Sale with the 13 Department of General Services DATED SEPTEMBER 10, 2002. 14 The property to be conveyed pursuant to subsection (a) 15 consists of approximately 212.17 acres and numerous buildings

- 15 (c) The conveyance shall be made under and subject to all
- 16 lawful and enforceable easements, servitudes and rights of
- 17 others, including but not confined to streets, roadways and
- 18 rights of any telephone, telegraph, water, electric, gas or
- 19 pipeline companies, as well as under and subject to any lawful
- 20 and enforceable estates or tenancies vested in third persons
- 21 appearing of record, for any portion of the land or improvements
- 22 erected thereon.
- 23 (d) The deed of conveyance shall contain the following
- 24 restrictive covenant: UNDER AND SUBJECT to the restrictions,
- 25 limitations and conditions that the land herein depicted on the
- 26 attached site plan shall be used, and limited to, permitted open
- 27 space benefits as defined in section 2 of the act of January 19,
- 28 1968 (1967 P.L.992, No.442), entitled, as amended, "An act
- 29 authorizing the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the local
- 30 government units thereof to preserve, acquire or hold land for

- 1 open space uses."
- 2 (e) The restrictive covenant in the deed of conveyance shall
- 3 contain approximately 135 acres of open space recreation
- 4 restrictions on a portion of the currently undeveloped lands
- 5 conveyed, consistent with the terms established in the Agreement
- 6 of Sale, to include approximately 120 acres to be reserved
- 7 strictly for passive recreation where active sports fields are
- 8 prohibited and that may include hiking and biking trails and
- 9 picnic pavilions.
- 10 (f) The deed of conveyance shall be by Special Warranty Deed
- 11 and shall be executed by the Secretary of General Services in
- 12 the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 13 (g) Costs and fees incidental to this conveyance shall be
- 14 borne by the Grantee.
- 15 (h) The cost and fees incurred by the Department of General
- 16 Services for preparing the property for sale, including, but not
- 17 limited to, environmental assessments, marketing services, title
- 18 searches, advertising, appraisal, auctioneer fees and surveys,
- 19 and by the Department of Public Welfare for protecting and
- 20 securing the property shall be deducted from the purchase price,
- 21 and that amount shall be an executively authorized augmentation
- 22 to the appropriation from which the costs and fees were paid by
- 23 the departments, with priority reimbursements being made to the
- 24 Department of General Services and then the Department of Public
- 25 Welfare.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
