A RESOLUTION

Declaring that all Pennsylvania school students have the right 1 to the surety that they are safe, and requesting from the 2 Department of Education an accounting and evaluation of 3 professional guidance services and aid that can be provided 5 to local school districts. WHEREAS, In the wake of the tragedy of September 11, 2001, in 6 which thousands of innocent lives were lost, the nation searches 7 for answers to our children's questions and ways to allay their fears; and 10 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania finds its school 11 districts dealing with tough issues in unsettled times; and 12 WHEREAS, When once it was commonly assumed that school, next to the home, was the safest place a child could be, incidents of 13 14 terroristic violence, including those which occurred in 15 Washington, New York and Pennsylvania, have damaged this 16 perception; and 17 WHEREAS, The limited resources of many of the Commonwealth's

local school districts are being stretched near to capacity; and

WHEREAS, School districts are finding that the services of

- 1 professional guidance counselors are needed to aid students in
- 2 coping with and understanding terroristic violence; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Department of Education needs to take an active
- 4 role in addressing the needs of local school districts for
- 5 professional guidance and technical support; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Senate declare that all Pennsylvania
- 7 school students and their parents have the right to the surety
- 8 that schools and classrooms are, indeed, safe places; and be it
- 9 further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Senate request from the Department of
- 11 Education a report on professional guidance counselor services
- 12 provided by local school districts, including services directed
- 13 to assist students in coping with and understanding terroristic
- 14 violence. This report shall also document needs of local school
- 15 districts for professional guidance counselor services and
- 16 Federal and State aid that can be provided to local school
- 17 districts to meet these needs. This report is to be submitted to
- 18 the Senate by March 31, 2002.
