A RESOLUTION

1 Proclaiming the week of June 9 through 15, 2002, as "State
2 Veterans' Home Week."

3 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has, for more than 100 years,
4 provided a home for these distinguished veterans in need; and

5 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania will continue to honor its veterans by

7 RESOLVED, That, in recognition of our veterans and veterans'
8 homes, the Senate proclaim June 9 through 15, 2002, as "State

10 State-supported home in Erie, Hollidaysburg, Spring City,
11 Scranton or Pittsburgh and thank these veterans and the
