AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for boat registration fees and
- 3 registration renewal cycles for senior citizens.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5104 of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, amended December 9, 2002 (P.L.1542,
- 8 No.199), is amended to read:
- 9 § 5104. Fees.
- 10 [The] (a) General rule.--Except as provided in subsection
- 11 (b), the following fees apply to registrations, licenses,
- 12 permits [and], capacity plates and certificates issued under
- 13 this part and the fees collected shall be deposited in the State
- 14 Treasury in the Boat Fund:
- 15 (1) Owner registration (motorboats less than 16 feet in

- length), \$10 per year.
- 2 (2) Owner registration (motorboats 16 feet to less than
- 3 20 feet), \$15 per year.
- 4 (2.1) Owner registration (motorboats 20 feet or longer),
- 5 \$20 per year.
- 6 (2.2) Owner registration (boats not equipped with
- 7 motors), \$5 per year.
- 8 (3) Duplicate owner registration, \$3 each.
- 9 (4) Dealer registration, \$15 each per year.
- 10 (5) Commercial passenger boat registration, \$25 each.
- 11 (6) License for operator of passenger-carrying boat, \$5
- 12 each.
- 13 (7) Capacity plate, \$5 each.
- 14 (8) Transfer of a multi-year boat registration, \$5.
- 15 (9) Permit for floating structure and private aids to
- 16 navigation, \$10 each.
- 17 (10) Boating safety education certificate, \$10.
- 18 (11) Replacement boating safety education certificate,
- 19 \$5.
- 20 (b) Reduced fee and renewal cycle.--Notwithstanding any
- 21 provision of this title or any regulation promulgated under this
- 22 title, any person who is 65 years of age or older shall be
- 23 entitled to the following reductions:
- 24 (1) A reduction of 50% for any boat registration fee
- 25 <u>assessed by the commission.</u>
- 26 (2) A renewal cycle of one year at the option of the
- 27 applicant.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
