## AN ACT

- Designating a portion of State Route 1040 known as Spur Road in East Cocalico Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as 2 3 Colonel George Howard Boulevard AND DESIGNATING A BRIDGE OVER RAILROAD TRACKS ON THE FRUITVILLE PIKE, STATE ROUTE 72, IN 4
- MANHEIM TOWNSHIP, LANCASTER COUNTY, AS THE GENERAL RICHARD M. 5
- 6 SCOTT BRIDGE.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Colonel George Howard Boulevard.
- 10 (a) Designation. -- The portion of State Route 1040, known as
- Spur Road in East Cocalico Township, Lancaster County, is hereby 11
- designated and shall be known as Colonel George Howard 12
- 13 Boulevard.
- 14 Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- maintain road signs, which shall display the name of Colonel 15
- 16 George Howard Boulevard, at the beginning and the end of the
- 17 section of the highway designated in subsection (a).
- 18 SECTION 2. GENERAL RICHARD M. SCOTT BRIDGE.

- 1 (A) DESIGNATION. -- THE BRIDGE CARRYING THE FRUITVILLE PIKE,
- 2 STATE ROUTE 72, OVER RAILROAD TRACKS IN MANHEIM TOWNSHIP,
- 3 LANCASTER COUNTY, IS HEREBY DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE
- 4 GENERAL RICHARD M. SCOTT BRIDGE.
- 5 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
- 6 MAINTAIN SIGNS AT EACH SIDE OF THE BRIDGE DESIGNATED IN
- 7 SUBSECTION (A).
- 8 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . Effective date.

9 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
