AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 29, 1996 (P.L.46, No.15), entitled "An
- 2 act providing for the prevention of hepatitis B and for
- 3 additional duties of the Department of Health, "further
- 4 providing for additional requirements.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of March 29, 1996 (P.L.46,
- 8 No.15), known as the Hepatitis B Prevention Act, is amended to
- 9 read:
- 10 Section 3. Implementation.
- 11 The Secretary of Health shall cause hepatitis B to be placed
- 12 on the list of diseases that require immunization for entry into
- 13 school after August 1, 1997, and on the list of diseases that
- 14 require immunization for attendance at school after August 1,
- 15 2003, in dosages consistent with the recommendations of the
- 16 Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices for the Centers for

- 1 Disease Control and Prevention of the United States Department
- 2 of Health and Human Services.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
