AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, further providing for annual budget, additional or increased appropriations and transfer of funds.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 687 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by
- 11 adding a subsection to read:
- 12 Section 687. Annual Budget; Additional or Increased
- 13 Appropriations; Transfer of Funds. -- * * *
- 14 (j) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this act, when

- 1 the annual State budget passes after June 15 of any fiscal year,
- 2 the board of school directors of each school district shall
- 3 receive a thirty (30) day budget extension from the date of
- 4 passage of the annual State budget THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS <-
- 5 OF EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY REOPEN ITS MOST RECENTLY ADOPTED
- 6 BUDGET WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS FROM THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH
- 7 FOLLOWING THE MONTH IN WHICH THE MOST RECENT STATE ALLOCATIONS
- 8 FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS WERE APPROPRIATED in order to reflect any
- 9 <u>changes in State allocations made in the annual State budget.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
