1 2 3	Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the prohibition against standby charges.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 1326 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 1326. Standby charge prohibited.
9	(a) ProhibitionA public utility that furnishes water to
10	or for the public shall not impose a standby charge on owners of
11	residential, commercial or industrial structures equipped with
12	automatic fire protection systems.
13	(b) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "standby
14	charge" means an amount however styled, in addition to the
15	regular rate, assessed against the owner of a residential,
16	commercial or industrial structure for the reason that the
17	residential, commercial or industrial structure is equipped with
18	an automatic fire protection system.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
