AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An 2 act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and 3 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and 5 protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and 7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and 8 supervision of insurance carried by such companies, associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by 9 10 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and 11 repealing existing laws, "further providing for automobile 12 insurance policy premium increases.
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. Section 2005 of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682,
- 16 No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended
- 17 by adding a subsection to read:
- 18 Section 2005. Policy Premium Increases.--* * *
- 19 (b.1) An insurer may not increase an individual insured's
- 20 premium or assess a premium surcharge on the basis that a
