6	Section 1. The definition of "waste transportation vehicle"
7	in section 6202 of Title 27 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 6202. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
11	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
12	context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	* * *
14	"Waste transportation vehicle." Public and private motor
15	carrier vehicles and waste trailers, as defined in this chapter,
16	[regularly used in] the primary use of which is transporting
17	municipal or residual waste to a processing or disposal facility
18	in this Commonwealth. ANY SUCH VEHICLE OR TRAILER THAT

TRANSPORTS MUNICIPAL OR RESIDUAL WASTE FROM A TRANSFER STATION
TO A PROCESSING OR DISPOSAL FACILITY OR FROM ONE PROCESSING OR
DISPOSAL FACILITY TO ANOTHER SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS PRIMARILY
USED FOR TRANSPORTING MUNICIPAL OR RESIDUAL WASTE. The term does
not include vehicles currently registered by the department
pursuant to 25 Pa. Code § 285.225 (relating to transportation of
residential septage) or consumer product delivery trucks.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
