## AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for 3 summary offenses involving vehicles. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 5553(c) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 5553. Summary offenses involving vehicles. \* \* \* 9 10 [(c) Exception.--Where] (c) Exceptions.--(1) Where proceedings are timely commenced against a 11 12 person reasonably believed to have committed the offense 13 charged and it subsequently appears that a person other than 14 the person charged is the offender, proceedings may be 15 commenced against the other person within 30 days after the

identity of the person is discovered and not thereafter.

(2) Where there are multiple offenses arising out of the
