AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for termination of 3 leases and similar obligations by military personnel. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 7315 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 7315. Termination of leases and similar obligations by 9 military personnel. 10 (f) Events subject to termination. -- A member of the 11 Pennsylvania National Guard or other reserve component of the

- 13 armed forces of the United States, as described in subsection
- (a), may cancel without cost, payment or penalty an agreement 14
- for the contemplated use of a facility or services to be 15
- 16 provided in connection with an event, and any deposit paid by

- 1 the member shall be refunded, where the agreement was entered
- 2 <u>into prior to the commencement of the member's period of active</u>
- 3 duty and the period of active duty necessitates the
- 4 cancellation. The notice described in subsection (c) shall be
- 5 <u>sufficient for a member to notify the vendor of the</u>
- 6 cancellation. This subsection shall not prevent a vendor from
- 7 recovering actual damages resulting from the cancellation.
- 8 Section 2. The addition of 51 Pa.C.S. § 7315(f) shall apply
- 9 to agreements entered into on or after the effective date of
- 10 this act.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
