AN ACT

- Making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania College of 1 2
- Optometry, Philadelphia.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$1,391,000 is hereby appropriated to
- the Pennsylvania College of Optometry, Philadelphia, for the 6
- fiscal year July 1, 2003, to June 30, 2004, for instruction. 7
- 8 Section 2. Payments to the Pennsylvania College of Optometry
- on account of the appropriation provided in section 1 shall be 9
- 10 made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of
- costs during the fiscal year and shall be conditioned on 11
- 12 continuing authority for inclusion on the Board of Trustees of
- the Pennsylvania College of Optometry of a minimum of five 13
- 14 persons who are not elected officials and who are appointed by
- 15 the Governor, the President pro tempore of the Senate, the
- Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 16
- Representatives and the Minority Leader of the House of 17

- 1 Representatives for terms of office coterminous with that of the
- 2 respective appointing authority; and shall be further
- 3 conditioned on these appointees receiving full voting rights as
- 4 members of the board of trustees.
- 5 Section 3. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall
- 6 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be
- 7 required by the Department of Education or the chairman or the
- 8 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate
- 9 or the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations
- 10 Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 11 Section 4. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall
- 12 report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial
- 13 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 14 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set
- 15 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the
- 16 "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State
- 17 System of Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-
- 18 State-Related Colleges and Universities."
- 19 Section 5. The trustees of the Pennsylvania College of
- 20 Optometry shall report on forms provided by the Department of
- 21 Education to both the chairman and minority chairman of the
- 22 Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the chairman and
- 23 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House
- 24 of Representatives by September 30, 2004, on how State-
- 25 appropriated funds were expended for fiscal year 2003-2004 to
- 26 reduce the costs to Pennsylvania resident students or to provide
- 27 services to Pennsylvania residents.
- 28 Section 6. Any moneys appropriated by this act that are
- 29 applied on an individual basis to students, including, but not
- 30 limited to student financial assistance, shall be applied in

- 1 such a manner that 75% of the appropriated funds are used for
- 2 students who are residents of this Commonwealth.
- Section 7 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, or <---3
- 4 immediately, whichever is later.
