## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act providing property tax or rent rebate and 3 inflation dividends to certain senior citizens, widows, widowers and permanently disabled persons with limited 5 incomes; establishing uniform standards and qualifications for eligibility to receive rebates and dividends; providing 7 for transportation assistance grants and grants to area agencies on aging for services to older persons; and imposing 8 duties upon the Department of Revenue, "further providing for 9 10 definitions and for funds for payment; and making a repeal.
- 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 12 hereby enacts as follows:
- 13 Section 1. Section 3(1) of the act of March 11, 1971
- 14 (P.L.104, No.3), known as the Senior Citizens Rebate and
- 15 Assistance Act, reenacted and amended December 21, 1979
- 16 (P.L.570, No.131) and amended June 25, 1999 (P.L.226, No.30), is
- 17 amended to read:
- 18 Section 3. Definitions.--As used in this act:

- 1 (1) "Income" means all income from whatever source derived,
- 2 including but not limited to salaries, wages, bonuses,
- 3 commissions, income from self-employment, alimony, support
- 4 money, cash public assistance and relief, the gross amount of
- 5 any pensions or annuities including railroad retirement benefits
- 6 for calendar years prior to [1999] 2003, and fifty per cent of
- 7 railroad retirement benefits for calendar years [1999] 2003 and
- 8 thereafter, all benefits received under the Federal Social
- 9 Security Act (except Medicare benefits) for calendar years prior
- 10 to [1999] 2003, and fifty per cent of all benefits received
- 11 under the Federal Social Security Act (except Medicare benefits)
- 12 for calendar years [1999] 2003 and thereafter, fifty per cent of
- 13 <u>all benefits received under any Federal pension plan</u>, all
- 14 benefits received under State unemployment insurance laws and
- 15 veterans' disability payments, all interest received from the
- 16 Federal or any State government, or any instrumentality or
- 17 political subdivision thereof, realized capital gains, rentals,
- 18 workmen's compensation and the gross amount of loss of time
- 19 insurance benefits, life insurance benefits and proceeds (except
- 20 the first five thousand dollars (\$5,000) of the total of death
- 21 benefit payments), and gifts of cash or property (other than
- 22 transfers by gift between members of a household) in excess of a
- 23 total value of three hundred dollars (\$300), but shall not
- 24 include surplus food or other relief in kind supplied by a
- 25 governmental agency or property tax or rent rebate or inflation
- 26 dividend.

- 28 Section 2. The amendment of section 3(1) of the act shall
- 29 apply to claims filed for calendar years after 2002.
- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
