AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 5 laws relating thereto," providing for the exclusion of pupils with limited English proficiency when calculating which 6 school districts shall be placed on an education empowerment 7 8 list. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 1702-B of the act of March 10, 1949 12 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added May 10, 2000 (P.L.44, No.16), is amended by adding a definition 13 14 to read: 15 Section 1702-B. Definitions. -- For purposes of this article,

16 the following terms shall have the following meanings:

18 "Limited English proficiency student." Any pupil that was

19 not born in the United States or whose native language is other

than English and comes from an environment where a language 1 other than English is dominant; or is a Native American or 2 3 Alaska native who is a native resident of the outlying areas and 4 comes from an environment where a language other than English 5 has had a significant impact on such an individual's level of English language proficiency; or is migratory and whose native 6 7 language is other than English and comes from an environment 8 where a language other than English is dominant; and has sufficient difficulty speaking, reading, writing or 9 understanding the English language and whose difficulties may 10 11 deny such individual the opportunity to learn successfully in 12 classrooms where the language of instruction is English or to 13 participate fully in our society. * * * 14

Section 2. Section 1703-B(a) of the act, amended or added May 10, 2000 (P.L.44, No.16) and November 22, 2000 (P.L.672, No.91), is amended to read:

18 Section 1703-B. Education Empowerment List.--(a) The 19 department shall place a school district that has a history of 20 low test performance on an education empowerment list. The 21 department shall immediately notify the school district of its 22 placement on the education empowerment list and shall publish 23 the list in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. A school district may 24 petition the department to exclude from its calculation under 25 this subsection or section 1707-B(a.1) the PSSA test score of 26 any student who was enrolled in the district for less than 27 ninety (90) instructional days of the school year in which the 28 test was administered. The PSSA test score of any limited 29 English proficient student who has not received appropriate bilingual/bicultural or English as a second language instruction 30 20030H1468B1854 - 2 -

- 1 over a period of at least one school year shall not be included 2 in the district's calculations under this subsection or section 3 <u>1707-B(a.1)</u>. * * * 4
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, or
- 6 immediately, whichever is later.
