- 1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled
- 2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration
- 3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery
- 4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of
- 5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes
- from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"
- 7 further providing for definitions.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The definition of "income" in section 502 of the
- 11 act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State
- 12 Lottery Law, added November 21, 1996 (P.L.741, No.134), is
- 13 amended to read:
- 14 Section 502. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 17 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 * * *
- 2 "Income." All income from whatever source derived,
- 3 including, but not limited to, salaries, wages, bonuses,
- 4 commissions, income from self-employment, alimony, support
- 5 money, cash public assistance and relief, the gross amount of
- 6 any pensions or annuities, including railroad retirement
- 7 benefits, all benefits received under the Federal Social
- 8 Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. § 301 et. seq.) (except
- 9 Medicare benefits), all benefits received under State
- 10 unemployment insurance laws and veterans' disability payments,
- 11 all interest received from the Federal Government or any state
- 12 government, or any instrumentality or political subdivision
- 13 thereof, realized capital gains, rentals, workmen's compensation
- 14 and the gross amount of loss of time insurance benefits, life
- 15 insurance benefits and proceeds, except the first \$5,000 of the
- 16 total of death benefits payments, and gifts of cash or property,
- 17 other than transfers by gift between members of a household, in
- 18 excess of a total value of \$300, but shall not include surplus
- 19 food or other relief in kind supplied by a government agency or
- 20 property tax rebate. The term shall not include an amount
- 21 equivalent to the amount of the average annual cost-of-living
- 22 increase under the Federal Social Security Act taking effect
- 23 subsequent to January 1, 2001.

- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
