Amending the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), entitled "An act relating to health care; prescribing the powers and duties of the Department of Health; establishing and 3 providing the powers and duties of the State Health Coordinating Council, health systems agencies and Health Care Policy Board in the Department of Health, and State Health 7 Facility Hearing Board in the Department of Justice; providing for certification of need of health care providers 8 and prescribing penalties, " providing for employment of 9 health care practitioners. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. The act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by adding a 15 section to read: Section 817.1. Employment of health care practitioners. 16 17 A health care practitioner may practice the healing arts in a 18 health care facility licensed pursuant to this act as an 19 employee or independent contractor. A health care facility shall 20 not interfere with a health care practitioner's professional

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
