AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for distress in school districts of the first class. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 696(i) of the act of March 10, 1949 9 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 11 amended by adding a paragraph to read: 12 Section 696. Distress in School Districts of the First 13 Class.--* * *
- 14 (i) In addition to all powers granted to the superintendent
- 15 by law and a special board of control under section 693 and
- 16 notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the School Reform
- 17 Commission shall have the following powers:
- 18 * * *
- 19 (15) (i) To, notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,

- 1 be the only entity to establish the rules and procedures for the
- 2 process for disciplining students. The School Reform Commission
- 3 shall deliver the rules and procedure to the Secretary of
- 4 Education within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this
- 5 paragraph. Upon receipt by the secretary of the rules and
- 6 procedure all disciplinary rules, procedures or standards
- 7 currently in effect in a distressed school district of the first
- 8 class shall be void. Upon adoption, any amendments to the rules
- 9 and procedures shall be delivered to the secretary.
- 10 (ii) A distressed school district of the first class shall
- 11 not be required to adopt or enforce any rule or procedure
- 12 <u>established by the School Reform Commission that is more</u>
- 13 stringent than those required by the United States Constitution,
- 14 the Constitution of Pennsylvania or Federal law.

- 16 Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
- 17 as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
