1	Amending the act of June 27, 1996 (P.L.403, No.58), entitled "Ar
2	act to enhance community and economic development in this
3	Commonwealth by restructuring certain administrative
4	functions and entities; changing the name of the Department
5 6	of Commerce to the Department of Community and Economic
7	Development; transferring functions of the Department of Community Affairs into the Department of Community and
8	Economic Development and other agencies; providing for a
9	Deputy Secretary for Community Affairs and Development in the
10	Department of Community and Economic Development;
11	establishing the Center for Local Government Services and the
12	Local Government Advisory Committee; establishing the Small
13	Business Advocacy Council; conferring powers and duties on
14	the Legislative Reference Bureau; and making repeals,"

18	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
19	hereby enacts as follows:
20	Section 1. Section 301(b) and (c) of the act of June 27,
21	1996 (P.L.403, No.58), known as the Community and Economic
22	Development Enhancement Act, are amended to read:
23	Section 301. To Department of Community and Economic
24	Development.
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- 1 (b) Functions to be consolidated. -- The functions transferred
- 2 to the department shall be consolidated within the department
- 3 into a bureau, division, section or other organizational entity
- 4 devoted to community and economic development and into the
- 5 <u>Center for Local Government Services under subsection (c)</u>. The
- 6 Governor shall appoint a Deputy Secretary for Community Affairs
- 7 and Development and a Deputy Secretary for Local Government
- 8 <u>Services</u>. The [deputy secretary] <u>Deputy Secretary for Community</u>
- 9 Affairs and Development shall have the powers and perform the
- 10 functions and duties transferred to the department in subsection
- 11 (a), except for those functions and duties of the Center for
- 12 Local Government Services, as well as other such functions and
- 13 duties authorized by the Governor. The Deputy Secretary for
- 14 Local Government Services shall be responsible for the
- 15 <u>administration of the Center for Local Government Services as</u>
- 16 well as such other functions and duties authorized by the
- 17 Governor, including the necessary staff complement and funding
- 18 sources to adequately carry out the responsibilities of
- 19 administering the Governor's Executive Order 99-1 as it relates
- 20 to land use issues. Such staffing shall include those personnel
- 21 presently assigned to land use functions in the department's
- 22 regional offices.
- 23 (c) Center for Local Government Services established.--A
- 24 Center for Local Government Services shall be established and
- 25 maintained in the department to serve as the link between the
- 26 Commonwealth and local governments. The center shall be a
- 27 provider of services to local governments, shall serve as the
- 28 point of contact for local governments on issues and problems of
- 29 local concern, shall be responsible for coordinating State
- 30 program resources in response to local issues and problems and

- 1 shall establish a systematic process for addressing local issues
- 2 and problems involving the resources of more than a single
- 3 agency. In carrying out its responsibilities, the center shall
- 4 use and have access to the information, services, functions and
- 5 other resources transferred under subsection (a). The center
- 6 shall, when authorized by the Governor, use and have access to
- 7 any other information, services, functions and other resources
- 8 in the possession of executive agencies under the Governor's
- 9 jurisdiction deemed necessary to the fulfillment of its
- 10 responsibilities. The center shall provide to local governments,
- 11 at no cost, information on purchase contracts for materials,
- 12 supplies and equipment entered into by the Department of General
- 13 Services in which local governments may participate pursuant to
- 14 the provisions of section 2403(h) of The Administrative Code of
- 15 1929. The Deputy Secretary for [Community Affairs and
- 16 Development shall be responsible for the administration of the
- 17 center and] Local Government Services shall report in writing to
- 18 the Governor and Lieutenant Governor on the activities of the
- 19 center. The center shall have permanent staff both in its
- 20 headquarters as well as in the regional offices of the Governor
- 21 and shall additionally make a toll-free telephone number
- 22 available to local governments to assist the center in
- 23 accommodating requests for assistance. Funding for the center
- 24 shall be provided by the department.

- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
