7	Section 1. Section 8304(b) of Title 24 of the Pennsylvania	
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:	
9	§ 8304. Creditable nonschool service.

11	(b) Limitations on nonschool service Creditable nonschool	
12	service credit shall be limited to:	
13	* * *	
14	(9) Previous service as a county employee, the total of	<
15	such service limited to five years, subject to the following	
16	limitations:	
17	(i) That during such service the person was a full	

1	time employee not employed as an independent contractor
2	or compensated on a fee basis.
3	(ii) That during such service the employee was an
4	active member of the county retirement system or, in the
5	event that no county retirement system existed during the
6	person's period of employment, the person would be
7	eligible to be an active member in the present local
8	<u>retirement system.</u>
9	(iii) That the period of such service used for this
10	paragraph shall not be included in or computed as part of
11	the total service with a county.
12	(iv) That the member makes contributions for this
13	service in accordance with section 8324(d) (relating to
14	contributions for purchase of credit for creditable
15	nonschool service).
16	(9) (I) PREVIOUS SERVICE AS A COUNTY EMPLOYEE OF THE
17	COMMONWEALTH OTHER THAN SERVICE AS A COUNTY NURSE. FOR EVERY
18	THREE YEARS OF PREVIOUS SERVICE AS A COUNTY EMPLOYEE, AN
19	INDIVIDUAL MAY BUY ONE YEAR OF CREDITABLE SERVICE, NOT TO
20	EXCEED A TOTAL OF FIVE YEARS. A FRACTION OF A YEAR OF THE
21	PREVIOUS SERVICE THAT IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN ONE-HALF
22	SHALL BE CONSIDERED ONE YEAR FOR PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH.
23	(II) PREVIOUS SERVICE AS A COUNTY EMPLOYEE OF THE
24	COMMONWEALTH OTHER THAN SERVICE AS A COUNTY NURSE SHALL
25	BE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS:
26	(A) DURING SUCH SERVICE THE PERSON WAS A FULL-
27	TIME EMPLOYEE NOT EMPLOYED AS AN INDEPENDENT
28	CONTRACTOR OR COMPENSATED ON A FEE BASIS.
29	(B) DURING SUCH SERVICE THE EMPLOYEE WAS AN
30	ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE COUNTY RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR, IN

1	THE EVENT THAT NO COUNTY RETIREMENT SYSTEM EXISTED
2	DURING THE PERSON'S PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT, THE PERSON
3	WOULD BE ELIGIBLE TO BE AN ACTIVE MEMBER IN THE
4	PRESENT LOCAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM.
5	(C) THE MEMBER MAKES CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THIS
6	SERVICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 8324(E) (RELATING
7	TO CONTRIBUTIONS FOR PURCHASE OF CREDIT FOR
8	CREDITABLE NONSCHOOL SERVICE).

11	§ 8324. CONTRIBUTIONS FOR PURCHASE OF CREDIT FOR CREDITABLE

14	(E) CREDITABLE WORK EXPERIENCE CONTRIBUTIONS ON ACCOUNT OF
15	T-C CREDIT FOR CREDITABLE WORK EXPERIENCE PURSUANT TO SECTION
16	8304(B)(6) AND (9) SHALL BE THE PRESENT VALUE OF THE FULL
17	ACTUARIAL COST OF THE INCREASE IN THE PROJECTED SUPERANNUATION
18	ANNUITY CAUSED BY THE ADDITIONAL SERVICE CREDITED ON ACCOUNT OF
19	THE PURCHASE OF CREDITABLE WORK EXPERIENCE. THE AMOUNT PAID FOR
20	THE PURCHASE OF CREDIT FOR CREDITABLE WORK EXPERIENCE SHALL NOT
21	BE PAYABLE AS A LUMP SUM UNDER SECTION 8345(A)(4)(III) (RELATING
22	TO MEMBER'S OPTIONS). [ANY INDIVIDUAL ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN
23	ANNUITY, EXCLUDING AN ANNUITY RECEIVED UNDER THE FEDERAL SOCIAL
24	SECURITY ACT (42 U.S.C. § 301 ET SEQ.), IN ANOTHER PENSION
25	SYSTEM, OTHER THAN A MILITARY PENSION SYSTEM, SHALL NOT BE
26	ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE THIS SERVICE.]
