## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for wild turkey hunting.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Sections 2705 and 2709(a) of Title 34 of the
- 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding
- 7 paragraphs to read:
- 8 § 2705. Classes of licenses.
- 9 Unless otherwise provided, any person wishing to exercise any
- 10 of the privileges granted by this title shall first secure the
- 11 applicable resident or nonresident hunting or furtaker license
- 12 as follows:

- 14 (16) Special wild turkey license to be used in
- 15 conjunction with an adult or junior resident license, adult
- or junior nonresident license, senior resident license,

- 1 senior resident lifetime license, senior lifetime resident
- 2 <u>combination hunting and furtaking license and junior resident</u>
- 3 <u>and nonresident combination hunting and furtaking license</u>
- 4 when the commission, by regulation, authorizes the harvest of
- 5 wild turkeys over and above the number of turkey harvest tags
- 6 <u>attached to the preceding licenses.</u>
- 7 § 2709. License costs and fees.
- 8 (a) License costs. -- Any person who qualifies under the
- 9 provisions of this chapter shall be issued the applicable
- 10 license upon payment of the following costs and the issuing
- 11 agent's fee:

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
